WHAT IS FAMILY INTEGRATED CARE?


A model of care in the NICU where parents are the primary caregivers for their infants

Including:



- Feedings (breast, bottle, and tube feeds)
- Diaper changes
- Obtaining Vital signs
- Bathing
- Giving oral medications
- Tracking progress
- Participating in medical rounds
- Decision-making
- Keeping record of care (charting)
- Weighing babies

OUR AIM WITH FAMILY INTEGRATED CARE:



"To work in partnership with parents to create a consistent and nurturing environment where parents feel engaged, enabled, educated, and empowered as the primary caregivers for their baby. We believe parents are experts in their baby's care. The overarching goal of family integrated care is to support parents in becoming equal members of the neonatal team and participate in providing active care for their infant with the help of a competency-based training"

WHAT ARE THE GOOD THINGS ABOUT FAMILY INTEGRATED CARE?

- Gain weight
- Shorter stay in the hospital
- Better feedings by breast or bottle
- You will bond with your baby
- Your baby will have the same care day to day



- There will be less stress while your baby is in the hospital and when you get home
- You will have more confidence about caring for your baby at home
- You will be able to build a relationship with the people working with your baby

This sounds great! When can I start?

Family Integrated Care is for <u>every family</u> in the NICU and there are a few things you should know



TO PARTICIPATE:

Just ask someone on your care team and they will get you started...

Use the check off sheet to track your progress. This sheet also helps the care team know what you ambiguity pendent with and what you are learning.

Utilize the tip sheet as to which order we recommend you learn each task

Speak up if there is any portion you are not interested in learning. You are not required to learn everything

If possible, spend at least 2 care times/day to be as

*we would love to have you try presenting at rounds when you are present. (morning rounds 10:30am to 1230pm, or evening rounds 830pm to 10pm)

DOES THIS MEAN MY BABY DOESN'T HAVE A NURSE?

Nurses will be educating you, along with modules and videos, on the skills you need to provide the primary care for your baby

Your nurse will be coaching, guiding, and supporting you through this exciting time


Nurses will continue to:

- Assess, implement, re-asses, and evaluate care given
- Provide respiratory care in collaboration with the respiratory therapist
- Provide IV therapy and medications
- Be available in case of an emergency
- Collaborate with you and the entire medical team to provide the best care possible
- Interpret vital signs
- Perform laboratory testing as needed
- Maintain all needed equipment for your baby

HOW WILL I LEARN THESE SKILLS?

- Online, module-based training
- Videos
- Quizzes
- Hands on teaching and practice with your baby's nurse

What if I have to miss a day?

Missing a day is no problem. Please let your nurses know your planned schedule if you can.

You can choose which activities you would like to do with your baby.


What if my baby gets sick?
